

Terms and Conditions for the "Make the Future Schools Programme 2018"

1. These terms and conditions shall apply to the Shell Make the Future Schools Programme 2018 ("Programme") organised by Shell Eastern Petroleum (Pte) Ltd ("Shell").
2. By registering or taking part in the Programme, you agree to be bound by these Programme Terms and Conditions and the decisions of Shell in relation to and in connection with the Programme.
3. The Programme is from 25th December 2017 0000hrs to 11th March 2018 2359hrs, both dates inclusive ("Programme Period").
4. Shell reserves the right to change the Programme Period.

Programme

5. The Programme consists of a visit to Make the Future festival at Changi Exhibition Centre ("MTF Visit") and the Energy Explorer Quiz ("Quiz") from 8 to 9 March 2018.

Eligibility Criteria

6. The Programme is open to all Singapore schools registered with the Ministry of Education or Committee for Private Education (each a "School").
7. To qualify for the Programme, a teacher with the School who is responsible for and shall be acting guardian for and on behalf of the Students (each a "Teacher") needs to submit the online registration form at <http://www.shell.com.sg/makethefuturesgschools> (or at any link or location designated by Shell from time to time) on behalf of the School from 25th December 2017 0000hrs and 9th March 2018 1700hrs (the "Registration Period"). Any online registration form submitted after the Registration Period will be disqualified.
8. Shell has the absolute discretion to determine the eligibility of Schools. Such determination shall be final and conclusive and Shell is not obliged to give any reason for its determination.

MTF Visit

Reimbursable Travel

9. Schools bringing a minimum of 120 students from the School ("Students") to the MTF Visit will be eligible to have the coach travel costs reimbursed by Shell ("Coach Travel Reimbursement"). This is a limited offer and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis to eligible Schools. Eligible Schools will be notified in writing of the procedure for claiming Coach Travel Reimbursements after the completion of the MTF Visit.

10. Shell reserves the right in its sole and absolute discretion to determine which Schools will be entitled to such Coach Travel Reimbursement. The Coach Travel Reimbursement costs are neither transferable nor exchangeable for cash, credits, or for other goods and services, or otherwise, either partially or wholly.

Visit to STEM Sites

11. Shell will offer three (3) Schools a Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics ("STEM") educational visit ("STEM Visit") to the following locations:

- i. One (1) School will visit a Shell manufacturing site for a class of thirty (30) Students with not more than two (2) accompanying Teachers;
- ii. Two (2) Schools to visit a ticketed STEM educational exhibition at Science Centre Singapore a class of thirty (30) Students with not more than two (2) accompanying Teachers for each school;

12. A STEM visit includes two-way bus transfer from the School to the visit location, entry tickets and meals for the visitors, if applicable.

13. To qualify for a STEM Visit, Teachers must ensure that at least 80% of the registered Students of the School have attended the MTF Visit ("Qualified Schools").

14. Qualified Schools will be selected at random at the discretion of Shell. Only three (3) winners in total will be selected from the Qualified Schools. One (1) School will be selected in January 2018; and two (2) in Mar 2018. Selected Schools will be informed by Shell in writing and selected Schools must reply within fourteen (14) days of such notification from Shell.

15. The STEM Visit is neither transferable nor exchangeable for cash, credits, or for other goods and services, or otherwise, either partially or wholly.

16. Shell reserves the right to, at any time and in its sole and absolute discretion, replace and/or substitute the STEM Visit with any other visit of similar purpose of its choosing.

17. In the event that the STEM Visit cannot be completed by 30 June 2018 or, for whatever reason the School cannot accept or fulfil the STEM Visit, or if Shell is unable to make contact with any relevant School within fourteen (14) days after the relevant timeframe for notification stated in these Terms and Conditions, Shell reserves the right to award it to an alternative Qualified School without liability to the originally selected Qualified School, as applicable.

The 'Energy Explorer' Quiz

18. The Quiz is open for all pupils of the Schools which attend the Programme from 8 to 9 March 2018 ("Eligible Pupils").

19. To qualify for the Quiz, Teachers of the Schools must expressly accept the offer during registration to the Programme.
20. Each Eligible Pupil is only entitled to one (1) submission.
21. To qualify for the Quiz, Eligible Pupils must complete the Quiz worksheet and submit the completed Quiz worksheet at designated collection boxes located within the Make the Future festival grounds from 8 March 2018, 0800hrs to 9 March 2018, 1700hrs ("Quiz Qualifying Period").
22. Eligible Pupils who have correctly completed Quiz worksheet and submitted the same within the Quiz Qualifying Period shall be a Participant. Five (5) Participants will be selected at random at the discretion of Shell to win the Quiz (each a "Quiz Winner") on or before 31 March 2018 (the "Draw").
23. Each of the five (5) Quiz Winners shall receive the following prizes:
 - i. A one-hundred Singapore dollar (S\$100) shopping or gift vouchers for the Quiz Winner; and
 - ii. A box of forty (40) collectible toy cars for the class of the Quiz Winner.

Each of the Schools of the Quiz Winners shall also receive a five-hundred Singapore dollars (\$500) book prize. The School can disburse the book prize to its Students for STEM-related awards at its discretion.

Quiz Winners and their respective Schools will be notified in writing of their win by Shell and no later than fourteen (14) days of from the date of the Draw.

Collectively, all prizes won by the Quiz Winners and their respective Schools for the Quiz shall be the "Prizes".

24. The Prizes are neither transferable nor exchangeable for cash, credits, or for other goods and services, or otherwise, either partially or wholly.
25. Shell reserves the right to, at any time and in its sole and absolute discretion, replace and/or substitute the Prizes with any other item of the equivalent value of its choosing.
26. In the event that any of the Prizes are not accepted or collected by 30 June 2018 or a date of Shell's choosing or, for whatever reason cannot accept the Prize, or if Shell is unable to make contact with any relevant School and/or Quiz Winner within seven (7) days after the relevant timeframe for notification stated in these Terms and Conditions, Shell reserves the right to award any of the Prizes to an alternative Participant and its respective School without liability to the original Quiz Winner, as applicable.

Disqualification

27. Shell reserves the right to refuse participation, or to disqualify, at any time during the Programme, Participants or Teachers who have submitted incorrect or misleading information. Participants and/or Teachers who do not comply with these Terms and Conditions may also be disqualified from the Quiz without further notice.
28. Participants and Teachers will have no recourse against disqualification decisions.

Use of Personal Information

29. By participating in the Programme, the Participants (including the Quiz Winner/s) are deemed to have consented to the collection, processing, use, disclosure and storage of their personal data which may include their names, mobile phone number, e-mail address, mailing address and NRIC or passport number, image, voice and/or likeness by Shell Group of companies and/or companies hired by Shell for organizing and conducting this Programme, editorial, advertising, promotional, marketing and/or other purposes without any payment and/or compensation except where prohibited by law and Participants are also deemed to have consented to receiving promotional, marketing and other publicity information relating to products and services offered by Shell and/or its affiliates from time to time. If a Participant does not wish to receive such information from Shell, the Participant and/or its School may inform Shell of his or her intention to withdraw consent by calling 1800-261-5322 from Monday to Friday between 8.30am and 6.00pm. If so selected by Shell, the personal data of Participants may be used in news feature, marketing or publicity materials concerning this Programme

General

30. Shell shall not be liable or responsible for the quality or fitness for use of the Prizes, Coach Travel Reimbursement or STEM Visit and/or any injury, loss or damage suffered as a result of, or in connection with the Programme and/or redemption or use of the Prizes, Coach Travel Reimbursement or STEM Visit howsoever arising, including but not limited to, fulfilment of the Prize(s), Prizes, Coach Travel Reimbursement or STEM Visit, loss of income, profits or goodwill, direct or indirect, incidental, consequential, exemplary, punitive or special damages of any party including third parties howsoever arising whether in contract, tort, negligence or otherwise. For the avoidance of doubt, cancellation, termination or suspension by Shell of this Programme shall not entitle any party to any claim or compensation against Shell for any and all losses or damage suffered or incurred as a direct or indirect result of the act of cancellation, termination or suspension.

31. The decisions of Shell on all matters relating to or in connection with the Programme are final, conclusive and binding. Shell shall not be obliged to give any reason or enter into any correspondence with any person on any matter concerning the Programme.
32. In the event of any inconsistency between these terms and conditions and any advertising, promotional, publicity and other materials relating to or in connection with the Programme, these terms and conditions shall prevail.
33. Shell reserves the right at any time in its sole and absolute discretion to determine and/or amend or vary these terms and conditions without prior notice, including but not limited to cancelling, terminating or suspending this Programme, the eligibility terms and criteria, the selection of Prizes, Coach Travel Reimbursement or STEM Visit, and the timing of any act to be done, and all Schools, Students, Teachers, Eligible Pupils and Participants shall be bound by these amendments.
34. The Programme and these terms and conditions shall be governed by the laws of the Republic of Singapore and all Schools, Students, Teachers, Eligible Pupils and Participants are deemed to have agreed to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Singapore Courts.
35. A person who is not a party to any agreement governed by these terms and conditions shall have no rights under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act (Cap 53B) to enforce any terms of such agreement.
